We are pleased to announce that the Local 103 IBEW Health Benefit Plan is working with CVS Health to provide COVID-19 testing *free of charge*, and *without the need for a physician referral*, to all Health Plan Participants and their Dependents.

Testing will be available at Local 103 in the office trailer in the parking lot near the highway sign as well as at various CVS locations throughout the area. The testing at Local 103 will be "Rapid result testing" and will be running from 7:00am to 6:00pm weekdays beginning Wednesday January 20, 2021. Lab or PCR testing, as well as "Rapid result testing" will be available at participating CVS locations subject to store schedules.

Testing is **BY APPOINTMENT**. Please follow the steps below to schedule an appointment.

Step 1: Log on to www.cvs.com/employertesting. Appointments must be made via this link for this program. Enter your Home Zip Code and Date of Birth where indicated. In the "Employee ID or Student ID" field enter the 9-digit number under your name (no letters, no suffix) from your **Blue Cross Blue Shield card**. Click "Get Started" and go to Step 2.

Employer- and university-sponsored COVID-19 testing

We've partnered with select employers and universities to provide testing for returning workers and students.

You may qualify for a no-cost COVID-19 test sponsored by your employer or university. Provide some basic information to get started.

What to do

- 1 Provide your ZIP code, date of birth and employee or student ID number.
- 2 Select a testing location and time. You may be tested at a CVS location, your workplace or campus.
- 3 Bring **proof of identity, proof of employment or enrollment**, as well as your confirmation email or text message. Be sure to have your mobile phone in case we need to reach you.

Step 2: Choose a testing location and appointment date:

To be tested at Local 103, choose “Employer/campus Locations” and then an available date. If there are available times on the date you selected, they will appear in red boxes below the location. Testing can only be scheduled 3 days ahead.

You qualify for employer- and school-sponsored testing.

Select a location, date and time below. Availability may change throughout the day. If you cannot find an appointment at your preferred time, try scheduling at a different location or day, or check back later.

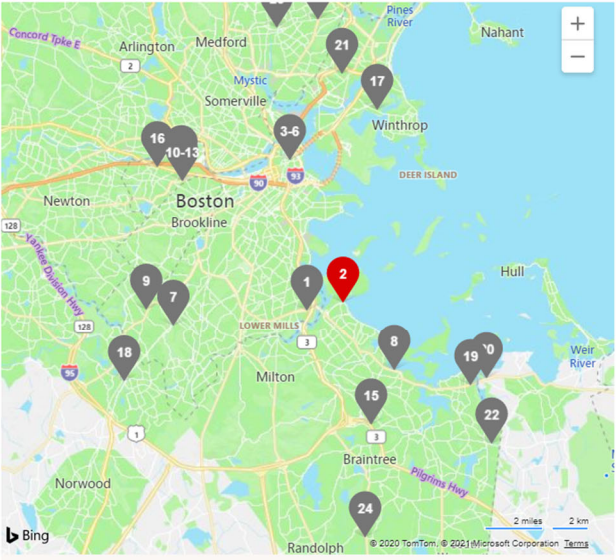
